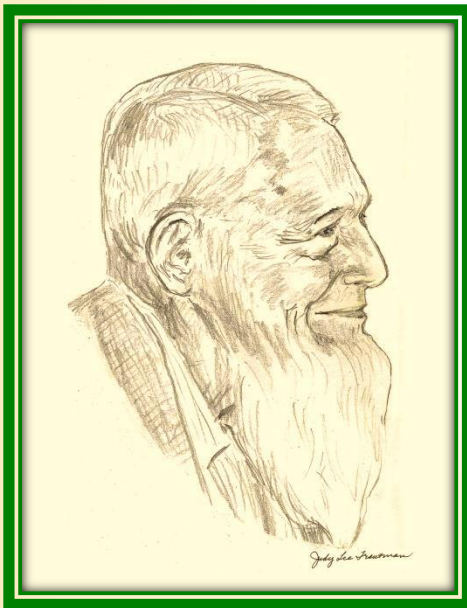

Deforest Lloyd “Woody” Trautman
June 14, 1920 – August 19, 2016

After a successful career in engineering education, Woody Trautman, retired from the President's Office of the University of Toledo. He remained in Toledo and continued work on technology and genealogy.

In about 2001, he started organizing MultiFaith events including World Religion classes, faith site tours, and the First MultiFaith Banquet at the Hindu Temple. In January 2003, the MultiFaith Council of NW Ohio was officially founded by Woody and his then new wife Judy. The MultiFaith Council remains active in promoting unity in diversity, compassion, and shared community service.

“Mr. Woody” became an iconic figure in all MultiFaith spaces and events until his death in August, 2016, at the age of 96.

His mantra was **“mingle and chat, understand and respect.”** His final words to all of us were **“Push On!”**
